According to the procurement allocation agreed by the ITER Parties the fabrication of the main vessel including blanket manifolds and hydraulic connectors is planned as follows:

European Union: 80%

Korea: 20%

In order to inform the interested industries potentially able to manufacture a sector or act as a sub-contractor for some specific item, on technical and administrative aspects related to the VV Sectors procurement packages, meetings (information sessions) can be organized by EFDA/ELE also in agreement with the International Organisation and the other Parties.
