(b) To be eligible for participation in this contract award procedure, tenderers must not be in any of the exclusion situations referred to in Articles 83 and 84 of the Financial Regulation of Fusion for Energy adopted by the Decision of the Governing Board of 22 October 2007 and as last amended on 18 December 2007.

In particular, tenderers shall be excluded from participation in a procurement procedure if:

(i) they are bankrupt or being wound up, are having their affairs administered by the courts, have entered into an arrangement with creditors, have suspended business activities, are the subject of proceedings concerning those matters, or are in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations;

(ii) they have been convicted of an offence concerning their professional conduct by a judgement which has the force of *res judicata*;

(iii) they have been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the contracting authority can justify;

- (iv) they have not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes in accordance with the legal provisions of the country in which they are established or with those of the country of the contracting authority or those of the country where the contract is to be performed;
- (v) they have been the subject of a judgement which has the force of *res judicata* for fraud, corruption, involvement in a criminal organisation or any other illegal activity detrimental to the Communities financial interests;

##### 5) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT LOTS

Candidates may submit a tender for one or several lots.

However, a separate tender must be submitted for each lot and each tender must be specifically targeted on the nature, workload and characteristics of the concerned lot.

Each tender must cover all the tasks of the lot to which it refers.

Submission of a tender for only some of the tasks in a lot is explicitly excluded and will lead to exclusion of the tender.
